Please note that to ensure variety, products/companies will be limited based on their type. Please email with any questions or to inquire if your company/product is already booked.

The organizer will have tables set up and assigned with a paper on each table stating vendor's business name.

- Vendor's are responsible for their own set up and take down of their own items
- Set up is between 8:30am-9:59am
- Take down is to be completed by 4pm
- Business name and prices must be clearly displayed
