On behalf of the Kipabiskau Cabin Holders Association (KCHA) we hope this email finds you healthy and enjoying this winter season. This will definitely be a winter to remember. As we were not able to get together for our annual meeting last May we thought we would reach out through this method.

As a cabin owner or seasonal campsite renter you and your family automatically become members of this association. The KCHA executive consists of the Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer, and Secretary and up to nine directors.
