Park Manager's Report

Well, winter is here, like it or not and a fresh layer of snow and ice covering the lake is a reality. I remind you that Kip is a river and has currents flowing beneath the ice, so please use caution when venturing out on the lake for your winter activities such as ice fishing and snowmobiling. We were able to get some last minute maintenance done before the weather turned on us and have repaired the drain culvert on the east end between HSE #6 and #7 and removed cabin HSE #2. We also improved the catch basin on the west end running east and removed debris from our various drainage trenches in the park. These improvements should help greatly with the movement of storm waters next summer. It is time once again to remind all Cabin Holder's that our garbage bins are for **HOUSEHOLD** garbage **ONLY**. It is your responsibility to remove construction debris, old furniture, bbq's and mattresses from the park and all cardboard boxes should be crushed before being placed in the bins. We are charged by the dump not by the weight. I will also be placing a 45 gallon steel drum in the bin area for fireplace ashes. These ashes should **NEVER** be tossed in the garbage bins for fear of causing a major park fire! Together we can work to keep Kip Park a safe and fun place for many more generations to come.

By having secure access to our Cabin Holder or Seasonal Camper "Log In" section you have private access to all things park related. In this section you will be able to access the "Park Bylaws and Constitution" "Year end Financial Statements" "Our Park Budget" "Water Quality Reports" "Kip Watersports Activities and Information" "All Park Store Information as well as a list of items available for sale and rental fees etc." and "Downloadable Documents, such as our "Park Leases" "Seasonal Campsite Guidelines" "Building Permits" "Change of Ownership information" "Various Application Forms" "Provincial Rules and Guidelines for ATV's and Snowmobiles" There is also a complete section with "Cabin Holder's Association Year End Statements" "AGM Minutes" "Contact Information" and "Reports" just to name a few. It's like having your very own key to the park office and filing cabinet. So if you haven't already "Registered" please take the time to do so. Cabin Holders and Seasonal Campers who have not "Registered" to our new communications website, click on "Register" and within a few hours you will receive your unique username and password. Then "Login" for access to all your park information. Then click on "Profile" and change the password to anything you desire and click "Save" it's that simple. If you have already registered and are having trouble getting logged on, you need not register again. In this case just hit "Log In" and click on "Forgot password or user name" You will receive an e:mail within a few hours with a new password. You can only register once per e:mail address. If you still are having trouble, please contact us at info@kippark.ca for personal assistance. Please check the website often and follow our facebook page. This is your website and was developed for you and is your personal source of all things park related. Please use it as your "Go To" website to keep the park lines of communication open.
