By having secure access to our Cabin Holder or Seasonal Camper "Log In" section you have private access to all things park related. In this section you will be able to access the "Park Bylaws and Constitution" "Year end Financial Statements" "Our Park Budget" "Water Quality Reports" "Kip Watersports Activities and Information" "All Park Store Information as well as a list of items available for sale and rental fees etc." and "Downloadable Documents, such as our "Park Leases" "Seasonal Campsite Guidelines" "Building Permits" "Change of Ownership information" "Various Application Forms" "Provincial Rules and Guidelines for ATV's and Snowmobiles" There is also a complete section with "Cabin Holder's Association Year End Statements" "AGM Minutes" "Contact Information" and "Reports" just to name a few. It's like having your very own key to the park office and filing cabinet. So if you haven't already "Registered" please take the time to do so. Cabin Holders and Seasonal Campers who have not "Registered" to our new communications website, click on "Register" and within a few hours you will receive your unique username and password. Then "Login" for access to all your park information. Then click on "Profile" and change the password to anything you desire and click "Save" it's that simple. If you have already registered and are having trouble getting logged on, you need not register again. In this case just hit "Log In" and click on "Forgot password or user name" You will receive an e:mail within a few hours with a new password. You can only register once per e:mail address.
