It is imperative that we at the park always have current and accurate contact information for all Cabin Holders and Seasonal Campers. This information is required for us to be able to contact you in case we have to updated your lease, or an emergency in the park arrises, ie break in's, fire, park notices or a natural disaster that may affect you or your property. It is also required for the Provincial Government to send education tax assessments, notices and invoices that also affect your park property. Over the past several years some of you have dropped your land line and moved to cellular phones, or have moved changing your mailing address, or changed internet providers and thus changed your email address. Some of you are snowbirds and are away in the winter months and are using a different email or phone number at that time.
