Park Administrator's Report

December is now upon us and the festive season is in full swing and with that, we have experienced some bitterly cold temperatures. I remind you that Kip Lake is a river that flows continuously. Although reports are that fourteen inches of ice is present, please use caution as it may only be a few inches thick in spots.

Our new shower house is really coming along. The building is completely closed in now and the doors and windows, metal roof, soffit and siding have been installed. Crews have completed all electrical wiring, plumbing rough ins, shower stalls, insulation and drywall. We are now working on taping, mudding and painting interior wall treatments. Sinks, toilets, counter tops and the remaining interior fixtures will be installed shortly after the holidays. Our deadline of February 1st is fast approaching, and Ryan's team are focused on completion, on time and under budget. Please follow us at Kip Park on Facebook to see up to date photos of the project as we continue to final completion.

A reminder: The Provincial Education taxes on your lake property, that were invoiced this July, must be received by the RM of Pleasantdale before December 31st.

The Provincial Government has renewed our Park Land Lease and we have been granted a 33-year lease term, which will now expire in March of 2052. By having secure access to our Cabin Holder or Seasonal Camper "Log In" section you have private access to all things park related. In this section you will be able to access the "Park Bylaws and Constitution" "Year end Financial Statements" "Our Park Budget" "Water Quality Reports" "Kip Watersports Activities and Information" "All Park Store Information as well as a list of items available for sale and rental fees etc." and "Downloadable Documents, such as our "Park Land Leases" "Seasonal Campsite Guidelines" "Building Permits and Rules" "Change of Ownership Information" "Various Application Forms" "Provincial Rules and Guidelines for ATV's and Snowmobiles" There is also a complete section with "Cabin Holder's Association Year End Statements" "AGM Minutes" "Contact Information" " Our Emergency Response Plan" and "Reports" just to name a few. You can even book your Septic Tank Appointments. It's like having your very own key to the park office and filing cabinets. So, if you haven't already "Registered" please take the time to do so. Cabin Holders and Seasonal Campers who have not "Registered" to our new communications website, click on "Register" and within a few hours you will receive your unique username and password. Then "Login" for access to all your park information. Then click on "Profile" and change the password to anything you desire and click "Save" it's that simple. If you have already registered and are having trouble getting logged on, you need not register again. In this case just hit "Log In" and click on "Forgot Password or Username" You will receive an e: mail within a few hours with a new password. You can only register once per e: mail address, so your family members must Register under a separate e: mail or share yours, whichever you prefer. If you still are having trouble, please contact us at info@kippark.ca for personal assistance. Please check the website often and follow our Facebook page for up to date announcements and safety notifications. This is your website and was developed for you and is your personal source of all things park related. Please use it as your "Go To" website to keep the park lines of communication open.

Dear Cabin Holder's and Seasonal Campers;

It is imperative that we at the park always have current and accurate contact information for all Cabin Holders and Seasonal Campers. This information is required for us to be able to contact you when we have to update your lease agreement, or an emergency in the park arises, ie break in's, fire, park notices or a natural disaster that may affect you or your property. It is also required for the Provincial Government to send education tax assessments, notices and invoices that also affect your park property. Over the past several years some of you have dropped your land line and moved to cellular phones, or have moved changing your mailing address, or changed internet providers and thus changed your email address. Some of you are snowbirds and are away in the winter months and are using a different email or phone number at that time.
