## A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

With the end of February quickly approaching, we look forward to a warming trend, so you can enjoy the many winter activities our park has to offer.

We will be invoicing all Cabin Holders and Seasonal Campers shortly for your 2020 lease fees. Please watch your mail and take note that we will be including a form to update your contact information. Please take a moment to confirm all your accurate contact information and return it with your payment, as we will be preparing new "Lease Agreements" for all Cabin Holders indicating the new lease that will now expire in March of 2022. You will also note that the park has implemented a Golf Cart Registration Process and All Golf Carts must now be registered for use in the park. This is a "One Time" registration of \$20 per cart and you will be given a unique registration sticker that must be fixed to the "Driver's Side, Front of the Cart" This process is being implemented due to obvious abuse of park rules and safety concerns.

We are happy to inform you that the Government have announced that no zebra mussel sightings were reported in any of Saskatchewan's lakes in 2019. We will continue to monitor this issue and ask that everyone makes themselves aware of the dangers of moving boats between lakes and take the time to ensure your boats is properly cleaned. In addition, we have had to deal with effects of unwanted materials, such as livestock manure grey water and garbage ending up in the lake. We ask everyone to review their approach to water quality and ensure we all do our part in making sure we have the cleanest water possible.

Even though the opening of the Park is three months away there is a lot of planning and activities that are being carried out. As we approach the opening, we will keep you informed about the things that are affecting your Park, so be sure to check out our website and Facebook page regularly.

On behalf of the Board, I would like to welcome all our new cabin owners and seasonal campers that have made Kipabiskau their park.
