## Park Administrator's Report

The fall temperatures have changed very quickly and I remind you that all docks and boat lifts **MUST** be removed from the water prior to October 31<sup>st</sup>.

You are welcome to store your boats and trailers in the upper compound during the off season, I only ask that you identify them, so we know who they belong to in case we need to notify you. If you have chosen to drop your trailers in the park maintenance yard without permission, you will be invoiced for storage.

We also have a burning pile in the upper compound and **ALL** fall leaves and branches **MUST** be placed there, as the blue garbage bins are for household garbage only. All construction materials **MUST** be removed from the park and taken to the landfill. Please understand the bins cost us \$100 + per dump and I remind you that we have security cameras in that area and there is a \$200.00 fine for noncompliance.

We will be taking care of basic snow removal this winter as we have done in the past. Please try to keep the area next to the roadways clear so the park tractor can pass by without incident.

The Provincial Government has renewed our Park Land Lease and we have been granted a new 33-year lease term, which will now expire in March of 2052. If you did not receive your copy in your email please contact me and I will make sure you get one. If you require a copy of the new lease for business purposes, a copy is available under the "Bylaws" section on the website. Please take a moment and add me to your contact information, throw me a text or send me an email. I am available during normal hours. Check our website often for park announcements and please follow us on Facebook. Make this your go to place for all Park information.
